The PhD programme in “URBAN PLANNING, DESIGN AND POLICY” offers 7 positions (of which 6 fully funded with scholarships) for the 36th PhD cycle at Politecnico di Milano. All scholarships cover three years of study and research.

This PhD programme aims at exploring the significance and impact of contemporary urban change as well as understanding the way the latter can be governed through planning, design and policy-making activities.
