HAVING REGARD TO the participation of Politecnico di Milano in the Erasmus+ Programme and in particular the current Agreement 2023-1-IT02-KA131-HED-000117197;

HAVING REGARD TO the programme agreed between the parties for the implementation of a Blended Intensive Programme coordinated by the University of Valladolid;

HAVING ASCERTAINED the availability of sufficient funding;

HEREBY DECREES

the issue of this call for applications for students wishing to participate in the Blended Intensive Programme (BIP) "Biological Carbon Capture Technologies".

Art. 1 - Addressees

This call for applications is open to all PhD students officially enrolled at the Politecnico di Milano. Applicants must still be enrolled at the Politecnico di Milano during the course. The applications of those who have already participated in previous editions of the course will not be taken into consideration.

Art. 2 - Project Description

This call for applications is for participation in the Blended Intensive Programme "Biological Carbon Capture Technologies" focusing on recent advancements in technologies for carbon capture and bioconversion into high-value-added products from various perspectives.

At the end of the course, the winning PhD students will be awarded 3 ECTS credits for the activities carried out. The recognition of the credits in the career of the PhD students will follow the rules defined by the PhD School.

Art. 3 – Submission of application

To take part in the selection process it is necessary to fill in the sheet available in the on-line form [link](#), by uploading the following documents in a single PDF file:

- Curriculum Vitae;
- Motivation letter outlining the relevance of the research topic to the course content.

All applications must be sent, under penalty of inadmissibility, by 12:00 pm (Italian time) on 24 May 2024.

Art. 4 – Selection process

A maximum of 5 PhD students shall be selected. The application Evaluation Committee is appointed by decree of the Director of the Teaching Service and shall draw up a merit ranking, based on the documents submitted with the application.

The merit ranking shall be published from 29 May 2024 and winning candidates shall be notified via e-mail, sent to the university e-mail address provided in the application form.

Participation is compulsory for the selected students. In the event of withdrawal from the programme, for exceptional reasons, Prof. Andrea Turolla (andrea.turolla@polimi.it) must be informed in advance.

Art. 5 - Allowance

The selected PhD students will receive a mobility contribution of € 79,00 per day for the 5 days of face-to-face activities. This contribution is compatible with the 50% increase in the PhD scholarship provided by Politecnico di Milano for the period abroad. In addition to the aforementioned mobility contribution, it will be possible to request a travel allowance of € 275,00, which will be granted upon presentation of the ISEE/ISEEU certification to be submitted before the preparation of the mobility contract. The travel allowance can only be granted if the ISEE/ISEEU value is less than € 24.335,11.

Art. 6 – Call Manager
