Context of the research activity		
Motivation and objectives of the research in this field	The research activities will be conducted within the framework of the ERC-NABUCCO project, which aims to enhance the structural efficiency of future aircraft by implementing innovative concepts based on the smart utilization of buckling-driven solutions. Although structural buckling has traditionally been seen as a potentially dangerous issue to be avoided due to its association with catastrophic failure, the nonlinear behavior linked to this phenomenon could actually be advantageous in the current drive for more efficient structures.	
Methods and techniques that will be developed and used to carry out the research	The research will be conducted as part of the ERC Advanced Grant NABUCCO, a project funded by the European Research Council of the European Commission. The methodology to be developed for designing aeronautical composite structures will involve an integrated approach encompassing analysis, optimization, and testing.	
Educational objectives	The goal is to optimize aerospace composite structures through a multidisciplinary approach.
