Programme

Mission and goals

The PhD program focuses on currently crucial themes for the preservation, conservation, management, and enhancement of the Architectural Heritage. Starting from the fundamental topics of knowledge, preservation, design and intervention, the PhD program takes care of the most important and ur-gent problems affecting the architectural heritage and cultural landscapes. The team of professors, promoting and participating in the debate about these matters on a national and international scale, will deal with a broad range of issues requiring strong and real multi-disciplinary approach. The PhD programme, part of the DAStU department, is meant as the place where theorization, methodology, and investigation into the most significant chapters of the protection of historic architectural heritage and landscapes are connected to complex, challenging operating research themes, fol-lowed by on-site and lab experimentation of analytical and diagnostic stages.

The program of study leading to the doctoral degree is organized in such a way that the students can get ready to contribute to enhance knowledge in the field of preservation of the built heritage and cultural landscapes; to enable to en-gage in advanced study and research; to integrate their professional educa-tion and experience with the larger problems of the research around the field.

Career Graduates of the PhD programme have often found employment in the Opportunities public sector and conservation institutions, in professional practices and in the business world, both in Italy and abroad. In Italy for example, in February 2018, due to a public selection proce-dure, twelve PhDs in Preservation of the Architectural Heritage become public officers in prestigious seats of the Ministry of Cultural Her-itage. Abroad, the PhD graduates found positions in prestigious interna-tional organizations, while others followed their academic careers in uni-versities and research institutions in their home countries.

Eligible students Italian and international citizens can apply. They are reguested to have a master of science degree or similar academic titles obtained abroad. The certified knowledge of the English language is a require-ment for admission. Please refer to the PhD School website for details.

## Scholarships
