HEREBY DECREES

the issuing of this call for the identification of students that will take part in the Blended Intensive Programme (BIP) "*Summer Course on Structural Health Monitoring*".

Art. 1 - Addressees

This call is addressed to all PhD students regularly enrolled at the Politecnico di Milano. Applicants must still be enrolled at the Politecnico di Milano at the time of the course.

Art. 2 - Description of the project

This call concerns the participation in the intensive scientific course "*Summer Course on Structural Health Monitoring*", whose main objective is to introduce the concept of structural health monitoring (SHM) applied to bridges and special civil structures.

At the end of the course, the winning PhD students will be awarded 5 ECTS credits for the activities carried out. The recognition of the credits in the career of the PhD students will follow the rules defined by the PhD School.

Art. 3 – Submission of application

To take part in the selection process it is necessary to fill in the sheet available in the on-line form [link](#) by uploading the following documents in a single pdf file:

- Curriculum vitae
- Motivation letter indicating the relevance of the research topic to the course content.

All applications must be sent, under penalty of inadmissibility, by 12:00 pm (Italian time) on 23 February 2023.

Art. 4 – Selection process

Up to 10 PhD students will be selected. The Commission in charge of evaluating the applications is appointed by decree of the Head of the Teaching Service and will draw up a merit ranking based on the documentation attached to the application form.

The merit ranking will be published starting from 1 March 2023 and the selected candidates will receive a communication to the University e-mail address indicated in the application form.

For selected students, participation is mandatory. Where a student is unable to participate for exceptional reasons, he must give timely communication to Prof. Maria Pina Limongelli (mariagiuseppina.limongelli@polimi.it).

Art. 5 - Remuneration

The selected PhD students will receive a mobility contribution of €70.00 per day for a maximum of 7 days: 5 days of face-to-face activities and 2 travel days immediately before/after the training.
