the issue of this call for applications for students wishing to participate in the Blended Intensive Programme (BIP) "Biological Carbon Capture Technologies"

Art. 1 - Addressees

This call for applications is open to all PhD students officially enrolled at the Politecnico di Milano. Applicants must still be enrolled at the Politecnico di Milano during the course.

Art. 2 - Project Description

This call for applications is for participation in the Blended Intensive Programme "Biological Carbon Capture Technologies", which will be held in Valladolid from 12 to 16 June 2023.

At the end of the programme, successful PhD students will be awarded 3 ECTS for their work. The credits will be recognised in the PhD students' academic study plan, as extra ECTS, according to the rules defined by the PhD School.



Art. 3 – Submission of application

To apply, you must fill in the form available online at the following <u>link</u>, uploading the following documents in a single PDF file:

- CV

- Motivation letter outlining the relevance of the research topic to the course content.

All applications must be submitted **by 12 noon (Italian time) on 8 May 2023**. Late applications shall not be considered.

Art. 4 – Selection process

A maximum of five PhD students shall be selected. The application Evaluation Committee is appointed by decree of the Director of the Teaching Service and shall draw up a merit ranking, based on the documents submitted with the application.

The merit ranking shall be published from 10 May 2023 and successful candidates shall be notified via e-mail sent to the university e-mail address provided in the application form.

Participation is compulsory for the selected students. In the event of withdrawal from the programme, for exceptional reasons, Professor Elena Ficara must be informed in advance.

Art. 5 - Allowance

The selected PhD students shall receive a mobility allowance of €70.00 per day for a maximum of 7 days: 5 days of course activities attended in person and 2 days of travel to/from the course location immediately before/after the course.

Art. 6 – Call Manager
